### **Alternate formats for this years Clear Lake Summer Jam**

**Class F (Slalom)** Those wanting to ski Class F in slalom will receive 4 passes with a maximum of 2 falls. You must declare you are skiing Class F at the starting dock before your round begins. There will be no recorded score for Class F within the Class C tournament. We will submit scores for Grassroots scoring. Visit the Grassroots section on [USAWaterski.com](http://USAWaterski.com).

**Turn -n- Burn** For slalom you can elect to take your final round at the conclusion of your first round. You must notify the boat crew that you are considering Turn -n- Burn before your round begins at the starting dock. Upon completing your round (miss or fall) the boat will stop. At this point you can make the decision. If you decide to Turn -n- Burn you will be taken back to the starting dock and will proceed with your final round. Starting speed and line length are your choice as it is a completely new round.
